



Alumni Cup Team Results

Turnberry, Prestwick, Glasgow Gales.

Following the success of the varsity team the Wake Forest Alumni captured a title of their own in Scotland, the International Collegiate Alumni Cup. The Alumni Cup is a specially created tournament for the Alumni / Boosters that accompanied their Alma Marta to the Home of Golf. Competed over three of Scotland's finest Championship Links (Turnberry Ailsa, Prestwick, and Glasgow Gales) the Alumni / Boosters represented their colleges against one another whilst staying at the luxurious Westin Turnberry Resort.



Using the stableford system Wake took an early advantage in the event posting a convincing 25-point lead over ACC rivals the North Carolina Tarheels after day one with 237 points (7 scores counting from 10) At the other end of the Alumni Leaderboard however, were the Georgia Southern Eagles. Unfortunately the Eagles over indulged in the famous Turnberry "Scottish Hospitality" the night prior to the 1st round and found themselves lagging some 48 points behind the leaders.

During the second round there was little movement in the Leaderboard, the Demon Deacons remained at the top with 461 points followed by North Carolina (435), Texas A&M (425), Texas Tech (424), Woford College (419), and Georgia Southern (416).

Georgia Southern led the charge on the final day in an attempt to avoid the wooden spoon with the best team score of the week, 248 points from their 3rd and final round at Glasgow Gales saw the Eagles climb to 3rd spot just 6 points short of second placed North Carolina.

Wake Forest secured the victory with a solid 228 points total on the final day over Prestwick, which had played the hardest course all week.



Individual honors went to Tarheel Don Holzworth and Deacon Joseph Millard who tied for medalist on 110 points, Barry Deal of Georgia Southern was a further two points behind in 3rd despite rallying to 42 points during his final round at Glasgow Gales.
